GOOD GOVERNMENT

- Reform and modernize New York's voting system and Election Law, including
 - o Early voting Enacted, Chp. 6
 - o "No excuse" absentee voting and Election Day registration Constitutional amendments received first passage by the Legislature
 - o Single Primary Enacted, Chp. 5
 - o Public Campaign Financing Public Campaign Financing Commission established as part of the FY 2020 Enacted Budget
- Bring meaningful and comprehensive ethics and rules reform to Albany

EQUALITY OF OPPORTUNITY AND EXPERIENCE

- Advance criminal justice reform and policies that will reduce mass incarceration
 - o Bail Reform Adopted as part of the FY 2020 Enacted Budget
 - o Justice Safety Valve Act Introduced as S.5712
 - o Second Chance Amendment Introduced as A.8588
 - o Domestic Violence Survivors Justice Act Enacted, Chp. 31
 - o One Day to Protect New Yorkers Act Adopted as part of the FY 2020 Enacted Budget
- Create a system for the production, distribution and adult non-medical use of marijuana in New York
- Promote comprehensive reproductive health policies and sexual education
 - Access to Contraception Comprehensive Contraception Coverage Act enacted, Chp. 25
 - o Reproductive Health Act Enacted, Chp. 1
 - o Maternal Mortality Review Board Enacted, Chp. 140
- Enact the Gender Expression Nondiscrimination Act (GENDA) Enacted, Chp. 8

THE JUDICIARY AND THE FAIR, EFFECTIVE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE

- Support the Judiciary's 2019-20 Budget Request, including adequate funding for civil legal services Funded as part of the FY 2020 Enacted Budget
- Enact the Uniform Voidable Transactions Act, which would modernize New York's laws related to fraudulent conveyances Enacted, Chp. 580
- Reform and modernize the administration of class actions in New York's courts Introduced as A.8034/S.6334-A
- Re-incentivize art authenticators and restore integrity to art transactions in New York

BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL PRACTICE AREAS

- Extend common interest privilege to business transactions
- Support long-established practices of business-to-business arbitration proceedings
- No automatic consent to jurisdiction by foreign businesses registering to do business in New York
