Applicants pay an Admission Fee that is a one-time payment equal to their first year's dues. The Admission Fee is waived in certain circumstances. Special dues rates may also apply (see below). Membership dues are based upon the earliest year of admission to any bar in any state or country, location of applicant's office, and work setting. Fees for judicial members and those without an office are determined by their legal residence.

Nonresident members are billed annually payable May 1. Student members are billed annually payable September 1. All other members are billed semiannually payable May 1 and November 1.

The Admission Fee is waived for anyone whose adjusted gross income is less than \$80,000, solo practitioners, all judicial and academic applicants; applicants in public law offices or public service law offices; law students; those joining within two years of law school graduation who are not yet admitted, non-admitted JDs, retired and former members.

Special Rates: applicants and members admitted 8 years or more and whose adjusted gross income is less than \$80,000 per year may pay \$165 semiannually.
