The New York City Bar's National Moot Court Competition Committee and the American College of Trial Lawyers invite you to sit on a panel of judges in the 67th Annual National Moot Court Competition. We are recruiting judges for Wednesday, November 16<sup>th</sup> rounds held at 3PM, 5PM and 8PM and on Thursday for a 3PM tie-breaker round, if needed.

This year's problem involves two distinct and timely issues: (1) the jurisdictional reach of states to enforce their sales and use taxes in light of Supreme Court Justice Kennedy's recent call to action concerning *Quill v. North Dakota* and (2) the scope of the "private citizen search" exception to the Fourth Amendment in the context of electronic devices. These two complex issues both arise due to the dawning of the technological age, and will be sure to challenge the research and analytical skills of competitors in new and exciting ways.

**Judges are eligible to receive 2 CLE credits** in Professional Practice. A minimum of 5 years legal practice is required; a background in litigation as well as appellate argument is highly desirable. We welcome you to forward this on to qualified colleagues who may have an interest in judging the competition!
