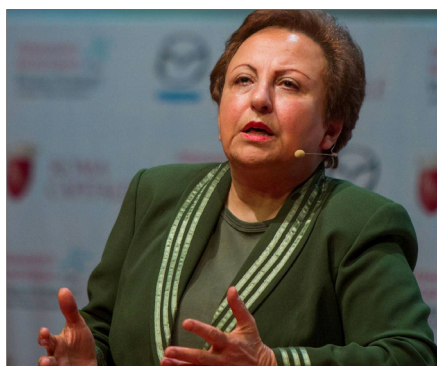

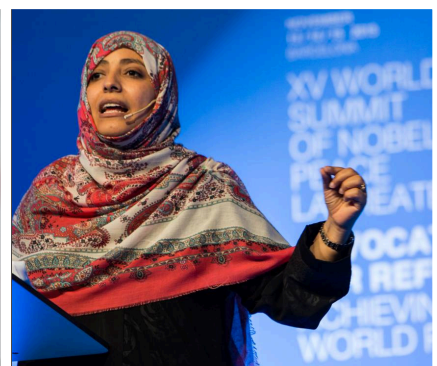
LEYMAH GBOWEE
